# Tom-Tom Tomahawk


#### Instrumentation

Snare, Tenors, Crash Cymbals,
Bass Drums, (2) Toms for each Snare player,
(Tenor players share the Toms with the Snare players)
Concert Bass Drum, Suspended Cymbal, Multiple Congas/Djembes

#### Performance Notes for "Tom-Tom Tomahawk"

Each snare player gets two toms: toms can be different sizes or the same size. The tenor players share the toms with the snare players by standing in between each snare player as shown. The toms should be tuned to a low mid-range like drum set toms. They should all be close to the same pitch. Players should place one foot slightly forward while playing to maintain a connection with the toms and remain relaxed. See the note for the visual at letter **D**.

Set up is as follows:



This set up can be altered for any number of snares and tenors.

The piece can be played without tenors playing on toms if there are a sufficient number of snares. In that case the tenors would play the tom parts on their #3 and #4 drums.
