Mash The Trash

Instrumentation

**Snare, Tenors, Cymbals, Bass Drums, Bells,
Xylophone (2 players), Suspended Cymbal, Cowbell,
Shaker, Metal Garbage Cans, Small and Large Buckets,
Large Pot, Small and Large Frying Pans**

Performance Notes: At letter **B**, the battery and pit percussion players play on different household items. For the battery, instruments are not removed for this, so the cans and buckets should be mounted to where the players can reach them with as little effort as possible.

Snares should be able to reach the large metal cans if they are mounted in front of them, perhaps with the player leaning slightly forward. For the tenors, the buckets should be mounted up high and angled toward the player, with the small bucket on the right.

The cymbal players should hold the trash can lids similarly to their crash cymbals. Bass drum players have an optional part that can be played on large rubber or plastic cans that can be either mounted or set on the ground.

All battery parts are back on regular instruments two counts before letter **C**.

For the pit percussion, the large pot and two frying pans should be mounted, either on cymbal stands or on a piece of wood, to facilitate going from the regular instruments to the kitchen ones.
