Notes from the arranger...


Since "buckets" have become such a popular percussion "toy" over the years, we thought it would be fun to incorporate them into a holiday Blast Off package! Each of these three ensembles are written with parts for Metal Keys (bells & vibraphone) & Wooden Keys (xylophone & marimba). If you have access to all four types of percussion keyboards... fantastic! If not, the tunes will still work with bells & xylo, only. Also included are the Bucket and Percussion parts. The bucket players have a bucket "key" in their "Up On the Bucket Top" part.

Keep a good balance between parts with the number of players you have. For instance, don't use eight bucketeers if you only have one bells and xylo player. If you can use all four different mallet instruments, you could blow it out to four to six bucketeers. Also, it may be helpful to split the percussion parts into two or three players, if you can. There are some quick changes between percussion instruments.

If you find the players are too shy to perform the rap in "Up On the Bucket Top", it can be omitted and will work with the stick clicks and written solos. (Remind them that rappers make a LOT of money, though!)

The buckets can be performed by placing them on the floor or snare drum stands. Use a thinner stick, which will add more life to your bucket top. :) There is also a pvc bucket-bar tutorial video, if you and your boosters wish to get adventurous! https://youtu.be/wRoC7B6KaCl


